

## Year Five Work at Home Activities

### English

- After Easter, we will be looking at books by Oliver Jeffers:
  - Design a new book cover for an existing Oliver Jeffers book. Write a blurb to go with it.
  - Look at Oliver Jeffers's website and then write a letter to him. Tell him about yourself and think of some questions to ask him.
- Imagine you find a magic key to a door. Write a story of your adventure. Think about the settings and characters you encounter. Make your work exciting.
- Practise your spellings on Spelling Shed.
- Choose a poem or extract from your favourite book and write it in your best handwriting. Practise your joins.
- Read lots of books. Write a book review of the books you have read.

### Maths

- Practise your times tables on TT Rock Star.
- Make a maths board game. Include questions with the four operations, fractions, rounding and other Year Five concepts. Use your Home-School Book to find some more.
- Practise the written methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Give some to a member of your family to have a go at and mark them.

## Topic

- Find out about charities who help people gain access to clean water. Create a presentation about the work they do. Include the countries they work in, how long they have been working, what they have done and lots of other information.
- Design a piece of Ancient Egyptian clothing or jewellery.
- Make a model of a pyramid
- Do some research about what life was like in Ancient Egypt.
- Research the different God of Ancient Egypt. What were their roles? Did they have any stories?
- Make a poster to show how you can keep healthy and eat a balanced diet.
- Sketch the view from your bedroom window.
- Make a warm up for a PE lesson. Take photos or draw the exercises.
- Make a poster to show how to wash your hands thoroughly. Make up a song or rap to go with it.
- Make a card for an elderly person who might not be able to go out and put it through their letter box.

## Science

- Find out about water resistance, air resistance and friction. Design a test to find out more about them. Carry out the test if you can.
- Space topic
  - Research why we have day and night.
  - Research the relationship between the Earth and the Moon. Explain why the Moon appears to change shape.
  - Create a fact file about a planet in our solar system
