BVS Guidance with Home Learning

As life continues in these strange circumstances, we are grateful to everybody who is continuing to support their child's education. We thought it might be helpful to produce some guidance and expectations for you so that there is consistency for all.

Expectations that children will:

- Use a pen for writing.
- Use a pencil for drawing and for maths work.
- Use a ruler to draw straight lines.
- Use pencil crayons to add colour to work rather than felt pens
- Write the date at the top of a piece of work: a number date for maths (29.4.20.) and a word date for other work (Wednesday, 29th April).
- Use capital letters and full stops.
- Take care with handwriting and try to be neat.
- When answering Guided Reading questions try to answer in full sentences.

Please note that work that is sent home each week does not need to be rigidly followed in the order it appears, unless stated. If you or your child is finding it difficult to work, do not feel under pressure to complete everything. We know these are difficult times for everybody.

Teachers will comment on any work you send but also feel free to send pictures of other things you get up to, e.g. baking, gardening, dancing etc. We love to see what you are doing.
