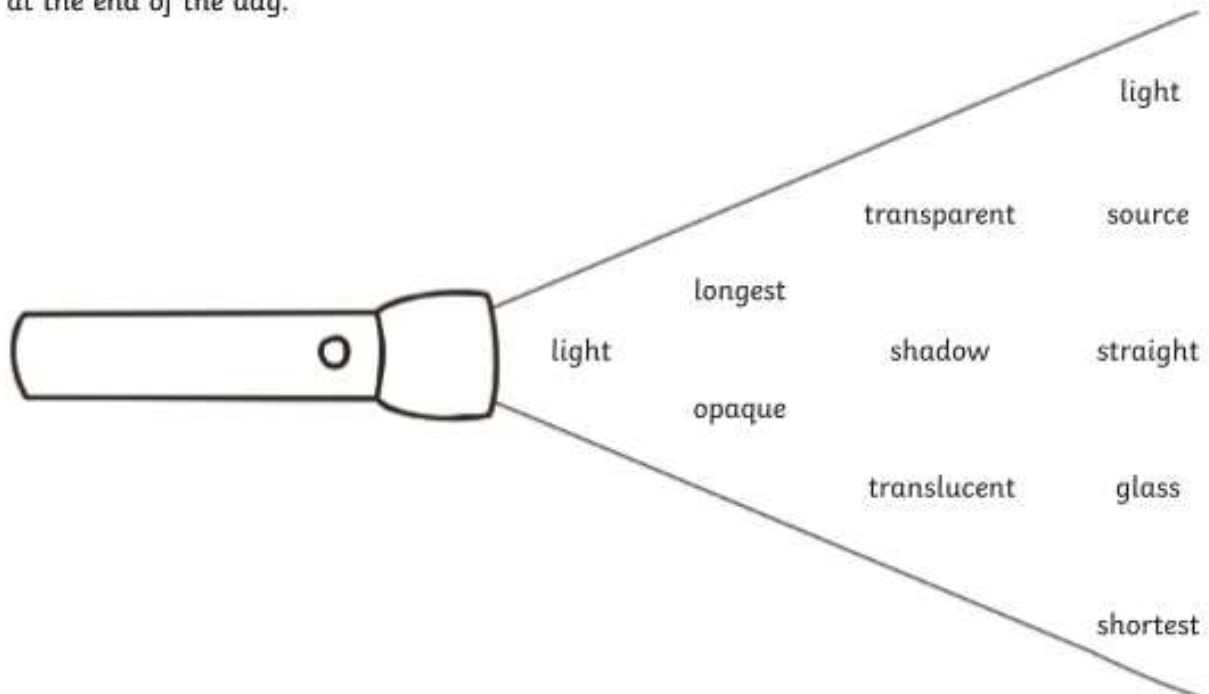


Light and shadows
