2. What are 5 lots of 9? (45)
3. What is half of 260? (130)
4. Write an odd number between 309 and 319. (311, 313, 315 or 317)
5. What number is 58 less than 85? (27)
6. Double 240. (480)
7. Multiply 27 by 20. (540)
8. What is 996 rounded to the nearest 10? (1000)
9. What is 1p less than £1.10? (£1.09)
10. I have 19p in one pocket and 47p in another pocket. How much do I have altogether? (66p)

For this next group of questions you will have 10 seconds to work out the answer and write it down on your answer sheet. I will read each question twice.

11. How long in minutes was a film if it lasted 1 hour and 45 minutes? (105 mins)
12. What fraction of the shape on your sheet is **not** shaded? (5/10 or 1/2)
13. The diagram on your sheet shows information about children in a Y4 class. How many were there in the class altogether? (30)
14. The Venn diagram on your sheet shows how some number cards were sorted. Add the number 33 to the diagram. (in the intersection)
15. Look at the sequence on your sheet. Write the next number in the empty box. 21, 17, 13, ?... (9)
