Answers for parents.

- 1. What does VE stand for and what did it celebrate?
 - VE stands for Victory In Europe Day and it celebrates the end of the war in Europe. (1 mark)
- 2. What two key events that ended the war in Europe, happened on 7th May? Two significant events that took place on 7th May were: Hitler killed himself, which made the Germans surrender. (2 marks.)
- 3. What do you think people felt when they switched their radios on at 3pm on 8th May?
 - I think people initially would have been very pleased (elated) and relieved when they heard the news on their radios. (1 mark.)
- 4. People probably felt different emotions when the war finished. What would they have been and why?
 - People would be feeling different emotions depending on how they had been involved and <u>effected by the war</u>. They would be <u>proud</u> and <u>relieved proud that the British had not lost and relieved that the fighting was over. Some may have <u>lost loved ones</u>, so would be feeling that <u>loss</u> and wondering how they were all going to recover.

- 5. Did World War II end on 7th May 1945? Explain your answer.

World War II <u>ended in Europe after the Germans surrendered</u>, but fighting <u>continued in the Far East</u> for a <u>further three months</u>. (1 mark for each underlined component.)
