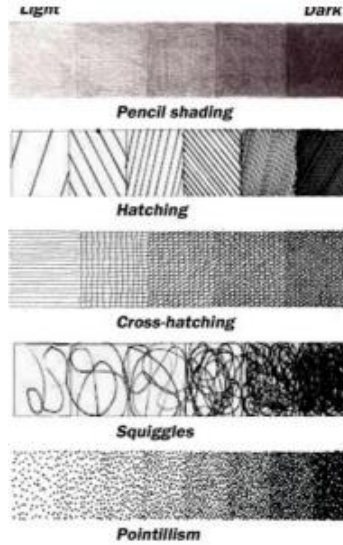
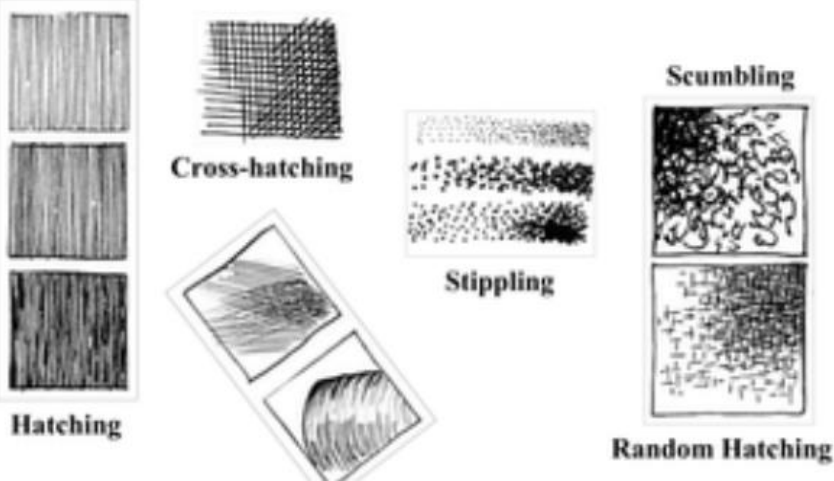


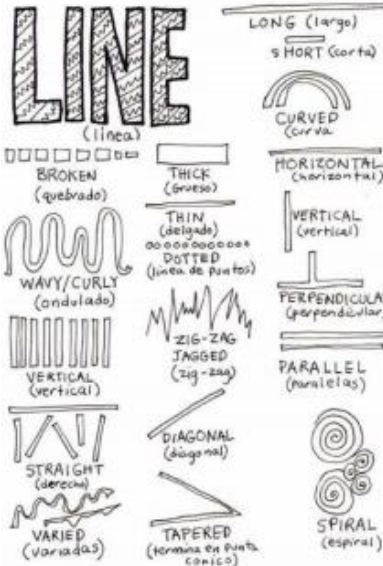

## Observational Drawing

Observational drawing is drawing what you see. It can be a flower, a person, a still life, a landscape, whatever. But it's drawing what you see in front of you as realistically and as true to life as possible. When we look at something with the intent of drawing it, we tend to look more carefully than usual. We see the texture, the pattern, the perspective, the light and shade, and how all of the details interact.



# PROPORTION

Proportion is the size relationship between two or more objects. It can be how the parts fit together to make a whole.



A change in proportion can change the way we look at things. Accurate proportions are used more when creating realistic images. Distorted proportions are used more for cartoons and imaginary images.
