

Subject Overviews

English

To begin the term we recap descriptions and look deeper into how to construct noun phrases to describe in detail before moving onto playscripts and the acting that goes alongside these! We will spend two weeks reading Anthony Browne's 'Voices In The Park' to explore Points of View. The children will still be receiving weekly spellings. Please help them to learn these each week.



Mathematics

We have spent a while developing the children's confident with the methods of addition,



subtraction, division and multiplication so now we will look at how well they apply these to different areas of Maths. We will revisit their arithmetic skills daily to keep these fresh. We will be organising a 'Methods Morning' where we will welcome you in to learn the methods with your children - we will provide

snacks! We urge the practise of times tables at home; this is crucial to the children's progress.

Science

During this term, we explore light and how we see it. We then move on to the study of animals and living things including the digestive system and teeth!
