General Reminders

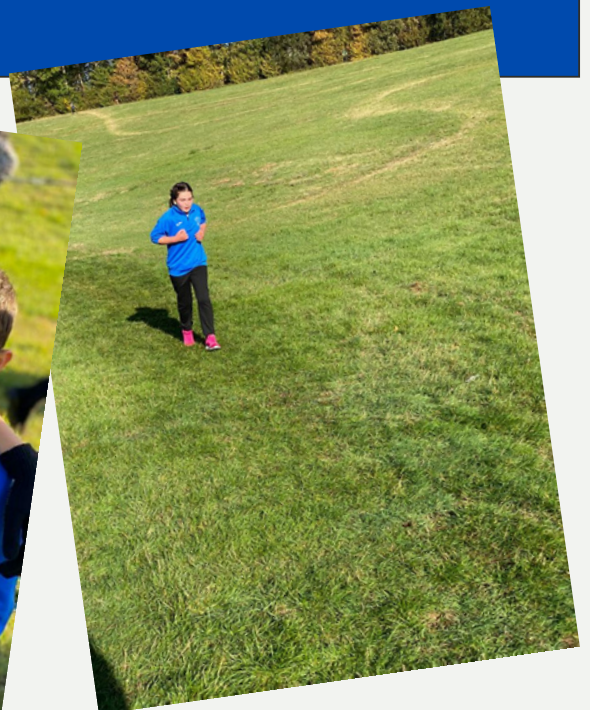
